Teen Domestic Violence Proclamation



Guilford County TTA President, Teen Melania Martin, contacted Greensboro Mayor Nancy Vaughan and the City Council to consider a Teen Domestic Violence Proclamation for our city. February is Teen Domestic Violence Awareness Month, and she wanted the city to stand against this violence. She stated that her maternal grandmother died from domestic violence. She believes her grandmother would still be here if she had been taught the early warning signs of domestic violence as a teen. She asked the Mayor and City Council to take a stand now, so this does not become an issue later in life.

Teen Dating Violence Awareness Month (TDVAM) is a campaign to amplify the needs of youth and their experiences with dating abuse. Teens, young adults, and their loved ones join in spotlighting this pervasive and harmful issue and how prevention and education can change the outcomes for those impacted by it.

Females between the ages of 16 and 24 are more vulnerable to dating violence than any other age group, at a rate that is almost triple the national average.


